Over the last few days, I have tried to find one word that adequately describes what we are going through and what many of us may be feeling. My thoughts have turned to words like uncertainty, unsettled, I have used crazy, incomprehensible, and fear. The truth is none of us know how all the steps we have taken, the efforts made to avoid COVID 19, or the preventative measures put in place to keep as many as possible healthy will turn out. I have discovered that one word can't describe everything we are going through.

I have also thought about the old spiritual "We shall overcome... someday" it is in the words of the song that we find truth. We shall overcome the pandemic of 2020. It will take a lot of effort, most of which will be inconvenient. It will take determination, because as we start to turn the corner the temptation will be to let up and coast. We can't. This pandemic has the potential to bring tears and will bring a lot of work.

I know Worship online is not ideal. But, for now it is the new normal. I know social distancing is counter intuitive, but very necessary. I know, this can be boring. For the first time I can remember, I have been at home by myself three nights in a row. I don't know how to act or what to do. I am betting you don't know either.

There are things we are doing:

- We have sent activity packets home to the preschool kids so that when they are bored the parents or caregivers will have resources. This will continue every two weeks until this is over.
- We have created a phone tree of everyone in the Church Directory App so that everyone will be getting a phone call from a member of the leadership team at least every other week just to check in.
- Members of the Stephen's ministry team are contacting home bound and shut in folks to offer support as
- Judy Smits has put together a plan for youth leadership to keep in touch with youth members.

Lastly, we will get through all this if we continue to try to stay connected to each other and hold on to the Faith in Christ that has brought us this far.

So, for now, keep doing, keep working at the new normal, keep praying, and don't lose faith. We shall overcome someday.




