PRE-SCHOOL AFTER-SCHOOL SUMMER CAMP

This last week we opened Summer Camp. Below you will find a copy of the letter we sent to parents as part of our effort to keep everyone safe.

Parents and friends of Shining Stars Summer Camp,

The State of Missouri is beginning to reopen after the expiration of the statewide stay at home order. We are aware that this creates a need for a safe environment for our children and at the same time presents continued challenges. The Shining Stars Summer Camp will open Monday, May 11 at 7:30 AM with the following protocols:

- One parent per family will sign in children at the back of the building without entering the facility. This will be done between the glass doors next to the Shining Stars entrance.
- ♦ Please use the hand sanitizer provided when signing in and out.
- If you use the church provided pen, it will be sanitized between uses.
- ◆ If you wish for your child to wear a mask you will need to indicate so on the sign in sheet and provide a mask.
- Every child's temperature will be checked before they enter the building and recorded on the sign in sheet.
- ◆ Any child that registers a temperature of 100 or higher will not be admitted.
- Mandatory hand washing and temperature checks will be conducted every two hours. If during the day a child registers a temperature, you will be notified and will need to pick up your child as soon as possible to minimize exposure of others.
- ◆ Individuals at risk (over 60 or with underlying health conditions) should not drop off or pick up children if it can be avoided.

Currently our custodians are in the process of sanitizing the building to create as safe an environment as we can.

Please note field trips will be delayed until further notice. We do plan for field trips in the future once the new normal sets in.

We are taking these steps to keep everyone involved as safe and as healthy as possible, while at the same time provide for the needs of your family and children.

If you have not registered yet and are planning to attend, please do so this week. Space is limited by staffing levels and state requirements. You can get the forms from our website www.harperumc.org.


