It is hard to believe that Christmas is just around the corner. We have started planning and thinking about how we can make Christmas stand out from all the other distractions we have faced this year. So far here are some of the things we will be doing:

- We are preparing 100 Advent kits so that families and individuals can participate when they worship either in person, zoom, or live stream on facebook @HC Live.
  - ~ Each kit will include:
    - \* The five candles needed to make your own advent wreath.
    - \* A devotional guide focused on the four Sundays of Advent and Christmas Eve. These devotions will be centered around the hymns we sing at Christmas that we will miss this year due to covid.
    - \* Individual candles so that you can participate from home when we have the traditional candle light service on Christmas Eve.
    - \* And, the possibility of a CD from our music ministry featuring Christmas music of the season.
- When you complete your Advent wreath, take a picture and email it to <u>office@harperchapel.org</u> We will take all the pictures and put them in a PowerPoint to share with everyone on Christmas Eve.
- We have sent out a survey to determine attendance plans, approximate attendance numbers, and anticipate attendance online. This will help us keep everyone safe with physical distancing and masks. If you have not responded yet, please do so that we can plan.
- ◆ We will be adding additional services depending upon survey results so we can stay within the safe gathering guidelines of the CDC at 25% of capacity or about 50 people per service. I wish we could have just two services with everyone in attendance, but Covid strikes again. To make sure we stay with in guidelines we will be using tickets for each service. You will be able to order yours when you complete the survey. Unfortunately, tickets at the door will not be available. (Tickets at the door kind of defeat the purpose, we will leave some room for guests)

This year we will be decorating the worship centers on Saturday, November 29th from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon. We plan on moving the Christmas tree to the front of the Sanctuary, and doing some things differently as we decorate for the Christmas Season.

We will be ordering Poinsettia flowers to in Honor or Memory of loved ones starting on Sunday November 1<sup>st</sup> to complete our decorations. Orders are due on Wednesday, November 11th.

We are not going to let covid stop us from celebrating the birth of our Lord, we are just going to continue to do things differently and be flexible.

These wonderful kids have filled bags and hung them on the line for God's Closet. Next month they will be assisting with God's Cupboard.


They want to make a difference and they have expressed a desire to serve.


Because we are so grateful for all of YOU, we're planning a Preschool Reading Buddy Day in November to celebrate thankfulness and friendship.


